I would like to request permission to attend the Summer Educator Retreat hosted by Pegasus Springs Foundation and Education Collective. This conference is for educators across the country to meet and reflect on their teaching. Through in-depth conversations with fellow colleagues from a variety of settings, I can learn new strategies to access, engage, and sustain complex learning protocols. This retreat will also allow me to develop personal skills as a teacher that I can share with my fellow teachers. School Reform Initiative: A Community of Learners will also be hosting workshops that I can attend. Those may include "Learning from Student Work," where teachers can learn how to use students' work to assess their level of thinking. Another opportunity for me would be to attend a workshop on "Blooming Questions," where I will learn how to develop questions that reflect the progression of thinking and responding to literature as a more evaluative level and not just literal. Another protocol that SRI has developed is called "Chalk Talk." The purpose of this protocol is to allow everyone in a group to participate and reflect on complex issues or questions in a thoughtful, quiet manner using only markers and paper. This may be another avenue for me to investigate at this conference.
